

Lake Whitney

Located at the top of the Texas Hill Country, the official "Getaway Capital of Texas" is centered around Lake Whitney with its crystal clear blue waters and dramatic limestone cliffs.



Covering over 35 square miles, the lake has 225 miles of scenic shoreline waiting to be explored. Picturesque coves, some with eye-catching waterfalls, offer pleasant surprises to boaters on the lake.

Many people get away for a week filled with activity. They join friends waterskiing or wakeboarding, enter one of the local bass tournaments, or test their skills on a four-star golf course.



Other visitors come back each year to relax. They spend their time enjoying a boat cruise of the lake, walks along the shoreline, leisurely dining, and evenings gazing as the sun sets in a burst of color over the lake.



Boating

Plan a fun day on the lake by renting a pontoon boat, deck boat, ski boat, personal watercraft, canoe, kayak, or paddleboat. Or plan to launch your own boat at one of the marinas surrounding the lake.



Fishing

Lake Whitney's reputation as a premier center for bass fishing is a big draw for the nation's fishing enthusiasts. Anglers enjoy fishing with a friend, with a guide, or as part of one of the many bass tournaments offered throughout the year.



Golf

There are three 18-hole golf courses in the area. Dramatic views of Lake Whitney and elevation changes are highlights of White Bluff Resort's "Old Course," while the "New Course" features lush fairways that gracefully wind through the trees.



Antiques, Art and Outlets

Antique collectors will enjoy shopping in the many antique shops and malls in Clifton, Hillsboro, Meridian, and Whitney. The town of Clifton, recognized as the "Taos of Texas," has a number of fine art galleries.

An outlet mall features stores that specialize in clothing, home furnishings, sporting goods, and more.

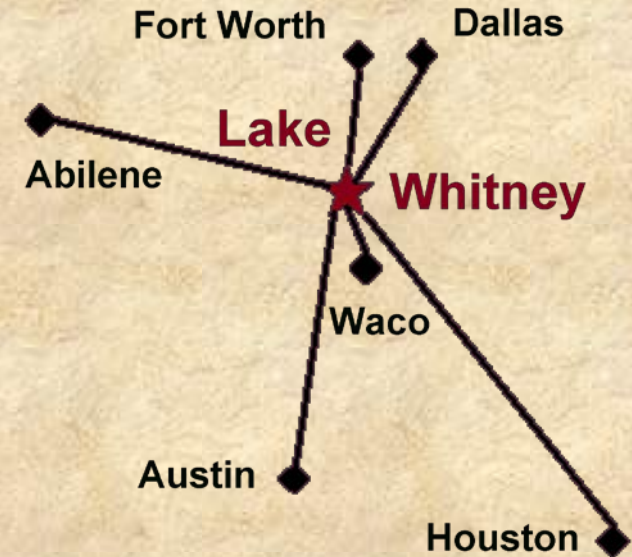
